INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Disconnect electrical lighting circuit (at breaker panel).
- 2. Secure all product segments to appropriate structural supports with grippers, aircraft and couplings. please check all local codes before install. (if mounting to dry wall recommend the use blocking per product weight, using appropriate hardware.

(**Mounting solely to finished wall tile is highly discouraged**)


- 3. Install RDU remote driver main enclosure, keep the lid open per RDU install instruction.
- 4. Remove top lid of the switch box and the lid of the control box (save the screws).
- 5. Pull the prewired line voltage, emergency and low voltage dimming harnesses that exit RDU main enclosure inside the C1 Sidecar to be connected at a later step.
- 6. Secure C1 Sidecar with Localized Switch Box to main enclosure with 4 screws shown in red (see images page 3).
- 7. Knock out two conduit holes on Localized Switch Box top face and run conduit. NOTE: Conduit and coupling by contractor/others.
- 8. Connect normal main line-in and ground wires inside left compartment of Localized Switch Box. Connect emergency line wires inside right compartment of Localized Switch Box.
- 9. Using prewired quick connects, connect the line voltage wires from LRMC-210 Series controller to the drivers via the corresponding harness from step 5.

Always follow power zone labels.

- 10. Using prewired quick connects, connect the EM line voltage wires and dimming wires to the corresponding harness from step 5.
 - (QTY of quick connectors vary based on configurations).

Always follow EM and dimming zone labels.

- 11. Close Localized Switch Box and C1 Sidecar lids with 4 x screws
- 12. Inspect wire connections.
- 13. Restore power to lighting circuit and test installation.
- 14. Enjoy your new product!
